The Nurse Faculty Leadership Academy is an international leadership development experience designed to facilitate personal leadership development, foster academic career success, promote nurse faculty retention and satisfaction, and cultivate high performing, supportive work environments in academe.

BY THE NUMBERS



NFLA Scholars experienced a **17% INCREASE** in their overall Leadership Practices Inventory (LPI) scores from the beginning to the end of the academy.



85% OF SCHOLARS stated an increase in their personal commitment to nursing education as a result of their NFLA experience.



All Scholars reported taking on at least **1 NEW LEADERSHIP POSITION** within their organization, community, or the nursing profession during their participation in the NFLA.



As an outcome of leading a team project in simulation to advance nursing education, one Scholar reported **175% GROWTH** in amount of simulations across six clinical courses within one semester.
