

## **Guideline for the Assessment of Professional Leadership Potential (Membership Eligibility)**

A student will have demonstrated professional leadership and/or potential within their community, academic, and/or work environment. Chapters may choose to have individuals submit documents that may include, but are not limited to, the following: curriculum vitae/resume; college or department committee work (i.e., student government officer, tutor, representative of college and/or department committees); or participation in community leadership activities such as non-profit agencies, hospital committees, and local programs.
