The 7-Step Integrative Healing Model was presented, along with a program called [HURU International](#) that helps girls in developing countries to stay in school by educating adolescents about menstrual hygiene and providing reusable supplies so that they can stay in school without worry of embarrassment about menstrual hygiene.
