Dr. Doris J. Froebe Leadership Education Grant Fund

During the 2017 Heritage Society Dinner, a major bequest from Dr. Doris J. Froebe was announced. She was a forerunner in nursing administration research and was one of the first Indiana nurse leaders inducted into the American Academy of Nursing. Doris was a proud member of Alpha Chapter of Sigma. Until she passed away in July 2016, Doris kept up to date with Sigma's global achievements in nursing through her visits with its CEOs and its Foundation staff members.



The Foundation recently received its largest bequest from Doris Froebe's estate and will use it to establish the Dr. Doris J. Froebe Leadership Education Grant Fund. The fund's proceeds will help the Foundation fulfill more of the large numbers of requests we receive from nurses around the world seeking financial assistance to disseminate their research at Sigma's congresses and conventions. The first grants from this fund will be awarded in 2019 at the 29th International Nursing Research Congress in Melbourne, Australia. The Foundation and Sigma are honored to receive this generous bequest from Doris. Also in recognition of this generous bequest, the executive office suite at Sigma's headquarters is now named the Dr. Doris J. Froebe Executive Suite.
