

Getting to Know You

One way to break the ice is to play Developing Honor Society Bingo. During this game, members will be asked to walk around the room and find another member who matches the criteria listed in one of the squares. Once they have a row of squares complete (or, to make it extra challenging, the whole board!), this member is the winner of a fun prize that the developing honor society has provided.

This fun activity can be carried out in three easy steps.

1. Download a sample bingo card from the internet. Boxes should contain information that lets players learn more about the individuals in the room and expectations the chapter has for its members, such as:
 - o This person is serving on a developing honor society committee.
 - o This person is already an STTI member.
 - o This person plans to renew next year.
 - o This person has a family member who is also a nurse.
2. Pass out cards to members and let them roam around the room to find other members who match the criteria in the squares. Have committee members approach members who seem hesitant to talk to others or ask questions.
3. Once players have names in a row of squares (or covering the whole board, to make it extra challenging), they win fun prizes such as:
 - o Gift cards
 - o Small monetary amounts, such as \$5
 - o Developing honor society pens, apparel, or books

This simple activity can be developed quickly and revamped each year or more frequently if you have new information to share with members.
