- Campaign with Wikipedia: HERstory (instead of HIStory)
  - Closing gender knowledge gap on Wikipedia more than 87 percent of editors are men
    impacts quality and perspective of articles are from men
  - 15 percent of articles are about women
  - Organize Edit-a-Thons series of events to edit info on Wikipedia provide training to women for editing, also train men on understanding their perspective
  - Contact Allyson to connect with them to get resources
  - Website: empowerwomen.org/herstory
  - Will provide resources/assistance to assist with creating local campaign
  - There is a women's group that has identified women's profiles/articles that have gaps/areas that need to be edited A list has been created.
