A 16-year-old girl took a six-month leave from school to explore developing countries and make a documentary film, using her camera to tell inspiring stories of people rising above their problems to show what is possible. She was an inspiration with her personal story and highlighted what work can be done in developing countries through chance meetings and interviews with people who shared their stories. The Global Sunrise Project showcased one of its own and her amazing work was innovative. The ambassador from Canada was also present. The group has developed a relationship with the United Nations office over time. Group members send a letter and request a meeting prior to every Commission on the Status of Women, and so far they have always gotten a meeting with someone from the Canadian delegation to listen to their concerns.
